

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Injury notification • Children notice parental distress and become upset • Spouse torn between job, children, need to be with service member 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Home routines disrupted • Need for emotional support • Dealing with the hospital system • Children visiting injured parent 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Loss of intensive hospital support • Unable to assume prior functions in family • Spouse must do more of parenting/caretaking 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Disappointment that old routines may not be possible • Children notice changed relationship with injured parent • Spouse and children have negative emotional and behavioral reactions


